Visit **Issyk Lake**, (another name of the lake is Esik, which means "door" in Kazakh) is a picturesque, high lake that arose as a result of the unusually beautiful nature of dense forests and tall flower fields. The lake is located at an altitude of 1760 meters above sea level, in the Issyk gorge of the Trans-Ili Alatau, approximately 70 km east of Almaty.



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DAY 03 ALMATY – ISSYK LAKE

Transfer to **Kok Tobe Hill** (1100 meters above sea level) to enjoy urban landscape view during sunset combined with natural zones.

Kok Tobe park is one of the symbols of Almaty city, meaning "Green Hill in Kazakh".

This hill (height: 1100m) is the city's southeast edge crowned by a 372m-high TV tower visible from far away.

Take a bird's eye panorama view of the city. It is especially beautiful at night when the light rivers are pulsing, car lights are flowing in an endless stream, and you look at this beauty from the heights and enjoy.

Dinner. Transfer to Hotel. Overnight.

DAY04

ALMATY – STAY VILLAGE

Morning: Drive to Charyn Canyon

Afternoon: Visit **Charyn Canyon**, after lunch, drive to Saty village. Saty is a picturesque village located in Kazakhstan, nestled in the foothills of the majestic Tien Shan Mountains. It is a popular gateway to the **Kolsai Lakes**, a stunning trio of alpine lakes, and serves as a base for travelers exploring the natural beauty of the region. If time permit, we can visit Kolsai lake. Check in to the

Guest house. Dinner and overnight.







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DAY 05:

SATY VILLAGE -KARAKOL KYRGYZST AN

After breakfast, transfer to Kegen border

Meet & Greet our local guide @ Kegen border (Kazakh/Kyrgyz border) Proceed to Karakol (110 km 2.5h drive)

Dinner: Dine with a Dungan family. Discover the 11 types of dungan dishes (Dungans are Chinese Muslim people who moved to Central Asia 150y ago).





DAY 06: KARAKOL – JYRGALAN VILLAGE After breakfast, enjoy a 1-hour drive to Jyrgalan village. Jyrgalan is a small village located in the far east of Kyrgyzstan, at the foot of the Tian Shan Mountain range. During Soviet times, the village thrived due to its coal mine, which provided many jobs to the local population. While some locals still affectionately call the village "Shaktar" (the Russian word for "mine"), the mine has been closed since the fall of the Soviet Union, leading many to leave in search of new employment.

Today we can experience optional horseback riding, trekking, mountain biking, and skiing. Once there, experience optional horseback riding, take a village tour, and enjoy a walk through this quaint settlement. Afterward, meet your bus and transfer to Karakol. Accommodation will be provided at a hotel, followed by dinner at a restaurant.

DAY 07: KARAKOL -CHOLPON ATA

After breakfast, drive through the **Southern Coast of Issyk-Kul Lake.** Stop for a **panoramic view of the Seven Bulls red rocks of Jeti-Oguz Gorge.**

Walk through Skazka Canyon and capture photos during the golden hour ~ about 2.5km (40-45 min walk) one way. The walk is mostly a sandy road and easy to "climb".

Recommended boots/mountain shoes for the day. Later we drive back in the direction of Karakol town until Grigorevka villageand turn to Ak-Suu canyon. This gorge suggests to the tourists' different opportunities to spend the time: Hike up along or sit down nearby the river and enjoy fresh air and the sound of the stream. Afternoon transfer back to Cholpon Ata and visit local ethnographical museum and Petroglyphs site. Today we spend day on the north shore of Issyk Kul Lake. Or visit ethnographical museum and Petroglyphs site. Dinner and overnight in a hotel.

On the way, back you will stop over at Charvak Lake. Charvak is an artificial lake, a popular resort in Tashkent region.

Return to hotel in city. Overnight in Tashken





DAY 11 TASHKENT -BUKHARA

Breakfast at hotel.

Transfer to train station for high-speed train to Bukhara as per timetable.

Arrival and transfer to hotel for baggage drop, check-in after 14:00. Lunch at local restaurant and start your guided walking tour in old city:

Folklore performance at madrasah. Farewell dinner at local restaurant.

- **Samanid mausoleum,** Chashmai-Ayub complex;

Depart to Samarkand by road. En-route visit famous ceramic school of family Narzullayev. lunch at workshop with homemade meal. Continue to Samarkand. By road is photo stop at Rabati-Malik, ruins of old caravanserai and water reservoir.

Start tour of the capital of the Great Empire of Tamerlane, The Rome of the East:

Gur Emir mausoleum, men burial site of Timurids; Ruhabad mausoleum from outside; **Registan Square consisting of Ulugbek**, Sherdor and Tillya Kari Madrasah;

Entry to Bibi Khanum Mosque, and Bibi Khanum Mausoleum from outside; Time for lunch at local café / restaurant. Continue tour visiting:

Colorful Siyab bazaar, gathering sellers and farmers from the area;

Shakhi Zinda Complex, known for beautiful mosaic, majolica and terracotta decorations;

Koni-Ghil – **handcrafts center**; Culinary master class followed by dinner at crafts center. Time at rest after the sightseeing.

Overnight in Samarkand.

- Passport copies for train/flight tickets must be submitted at least 45 days before the date of entry. It is best to send passport details at the time of booking so that the flight tickets for the domestic flight can be booked in advance.
- If the hotels specified in the itinerary are not available at the time of booking, other hotels of the same category will be booked.
- Many two-storey hotels in Uzbekistan do not have lifts.
- Hotel cataloguing is based on Uzbek regulations most hotels are 80% private and have their own Uzbek classification of stars. The quality of the hotels does not correspond to the quality of hotels in accordance with European regulations.
- Lunches during the trip are planned in local restaurants.
- The itinerary may change depending on the changes made by the airlines/railway companies in their flight schedules.
- Free baggage allowance per domestic flight ticket: 20 kg in a suitcase and 5 kg hand baggage.
- Boarding passes (HY, TK, SU) are only available at the time of check-in at the airport.
- The company is not responsible for the weather conditions during the journey.
- In the event of lost or delayed baggage, travelers go to the airport themselves to collect it (it is not usual for the airline to deliver it to the passenger's hotel). The collection of redirected baggage is not included in the price of the holiday.
