Best enjoyed in spring and autumn, this Nepal tour package perfectly blends adventure, culture, tranquility, and panoramic mountain beauty.

Itinerary 行程安排

Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu



Meals: Dinner



Overnight stay in Kathmandu at Hotel, elevation 1,350m



Arrive in Kathmandu. Meet and greet by Brothers Team representative and transfer to hotel. Trek briefing and preparation. if time permit visit Thamel bazar. Thamel is Kathmandu's vibrant tourist hub, known for shopping, dining, nightlife, and selling trekking gears. Overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 02: Drive Kathmandu – Dhap



Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



Overnight stay in Dhap at lodge, 2,850m



After breakfast, begin a scenic drive from Kathmandu through rolling hills, winding rivers, and charming rural villages, offering glimpses of everyday Nepali life. The journey passes lush forests, terraced fields, and small settlements where locals go about their daily routines. Enjoy the ever-changing landscapes and panoramic views of distant mountains along the way. Arrive in Dhap, a peaceful village at the gateway to the Pikey Peak Trek. Check into a cozy lodge, relax, and soak in the tranquil surroundings. Overnight stay at the lodge, preparing for the trek ahead.

Day 03: Trek Dhap – Jhapre



Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



Overnight stay in Jhapre at lodge, 2,920m



The trek from Dhap to Jhapre is a gentle introduction to the Pikey Peak trail. Passing through rhododendron forests, terraced fields, and traditional Sherpa villages, trekkers enjoy stunning views of distant Himalayan peaks, including Everest and Numbur. The path offers cultural encounters and peaceful landscapes, making it perfect for photography and acclimatization. Overnight stay in a cozy teahouse at Jhapre.



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Day 04: Jhapre – Pikey Peak Base Camp



Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



Overnight stay in Pikey Peak Base Camp- 3640m

The trek from Jhapre to Pikey Peak Base Camp offers a gradual ascent through dense pine and rhododendron forests, yak pastures, and scenic mountain trails. Along the way, trekkers pass traditional Sherpa villages and enjoy panoramic views of the surrounding Himalayan ranges. The crisp mountain air and serene landscapes make the journey refreshing and memorable. Arrive at Pikey Peak Base Camp in the afternoon, where trekkers rest at a teahouse, preparing for the summit hike.

Day 05: Pikey Peak - Loding



Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



Overnight stay in Loding, elevation 3,050 m

The trek from Pikey Peak to Loding begins with an early morning hike to witness the breathtaking sunrise over the Himalayan peaks, including Everest, Lhotse, Makalu, Kanchenjunga, Annapurna, and Dhaulagiri. After soaking in the panoramic views from the summit at 4,065 m, trekkers descend gradually through alpine meadows, yak pastures, and pine forests. The trail passes traditional Sherpa villages, offering cultural glimpses along the way. Arrive at Loding (≈3,050 m) in the afternoon, relax at a cozy teahouse, and enjoy the serene mountain surroundings.

Day 06: Trek Loding – Junbesi



Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



Overnight stay in Jumbesi at lodge, 2,700m)

The trek from Loding to Junbesi is a scenic descent through lush forests, terraced fields, and charming Sherpa villages. Trekkers enjoy peaceful trails with views of surrounding hills and distant Himalayan peaks. Junbesi, a traditional Sherpa settlement, offers cultural experiences, including visits to the Junbesi Monastery. The route is gentle and suitable for acclimatization, providing a relaxing yet rewarding day. Overnight stay at a comfortable teahouse in Junbesi.

Day 07: Trek Junbesi – Phaplu



Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



Overnight stay in Phaplu at lodge, 2,380m

The trek from Junbesi to Phaplu is a pleasant and relatively easy descent through picturesque villages, terraced farmland, and forested trails. Along the way, trekkers experience authentic rural Nepali life and can interact with local Sherpa communities. The trail offers occasional glimpses of distant Himalayan peaks and peaceful landscapes, making it ideal for photography and relaxation. Arrive in Phaplu (≈2,380 m) in the afternoon, where a comfortable lodge awaits. Overnight stay in Phaplu allows trekkers to rest and prepare for the drive back to Kathmandu.



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Day 08: Phaplu – Kathmandu by JEEP



Meals: Breakfast, Lunch,



Overnight stay in Kathmandu



Drive back to Kathmandu. Free time for shopping or relaxation. Overnight stay at Hotel in Kathmandu

Day 09: Kathmandu- Departure



Meals: Breakfast,

After breakfast, free at leisure till transfer to Airport and fly home.
